



Volunteers in Medicine Clinic is a free health clinic for Martin County residents who qualify at 200% or below the federal poverty guidelines. It is for people between the ages of 18 and 64 with no health insurance, Medicaid, Medicare or Veteran's benefits. Please call if you have Share of Cost. To schedule an eligibility screening appointment please call 463-4128 option 5.

Please bring the following information to your eligibility screening appointment.

- Photo ID – bring both if applicable
  - Driver's License or State ID with current Martin County address
  - Permanent Resident Card with Passport
- Social Security Card
- Proof of Residence
  - Current Electric or Water bill or Rental Lease Agreement
  - Car Insurance Statement
- Proof of Income for the last 2 months
  - Bank statements from all accounts showing beginning and ending balance
  - Pay stubs or letter from employer stating wages on letterhead
  - If self-employed, ledger and business bank statements
  - Notarized letter of support including \$ amount (form available)
  - Social Security Statements showing monthly amount received
  - Alimony; Child support; Unemployment statement
- Last year's Tax Return prepared by accounting service or Transcript from IRS
  - If self-prepared, for example using Turbo Tax, will need to get Transcript
    - Call the IRS at 1-800-829-1040 to get transcript mailed to you or call 1-844-545-5640 to make an appointment at 7410 US Hwy 1, Port St. Lucie to get it the same day. If you did not file a tax return, ask for a letter of Non-Filing. If married, tax returns or Non-Filing letters for you and spouse.
- Other documents may be required after initial meeting.
