





## A Heartfelt Journey of Compassionate Care

## **Partners for Life!**

Meet Sean and Sara, a wonderful couple whose story highlights the power of compassion and support in healthcare. While residing at Dunklin Memorial Church, a Christian based, longterm, recovery program, Sean and Sara sought regular medical care. Especially Sara had health concerns, being a lifelong asthmatic. Both became patients at Volunteers in Medicine (VIM) Clinic in early 2022. Little did they know, a serious medical situation was about to unfold.

Meet Sean and Sara, a wonderful couple whose story highlights the power of compassion and support in healthcare.



During a routine visit with his primary care provider, Alan Eddison, DNP, APRN, Sean's bloodwork revealed a dangerously low platelet count. As the situation persisted, and a visit to the emergency department was necessary, Dr. Eddison referred Sean to Hematology Oncology Associates of the Treasure Coast. There he saw Dr. Swanson and was diagnosed with idiopathic thrombocytopenia, posing a risk of bleeding out. Dr. Swanson prescribed a steroid treatment, and Sean went back for multiple follow-up appointments. This treatment ultimately resulted in his complete recovery! And the compassionate care didn't stop there - VIM Clinic continues to provide regular care to

obtain her asthma medications for free from pharmaceutical companies.

Volunteers in Medicine (VIM) Clinic has been serving Martin County since 1995. This would not have been possible without the support of our local hospital. For the past 27 years, the hospital has absorbed millions of dollars every year for labs, diagnostics, and ancillary services. With the transition to Cleveland Clinic Martin Health (CCMH), the number of providers has increased, and this has only enhanced the care that our patients receive.

A few of the extraordinary things that you may not know that we have been able to provide to our patients this past year include joint replacements, a craniotomy, aortic valve replacements, a spinal operation, surgical drainage for large subdural hematoma, hernia repairs, urological surgeries, breast cancer surgeries, opportunities to participate in clinical trials if appropriate, oncology and radiation therapy.

VIM Clinic is extremely appreciative of this partnership in being able to provide total comprehensive medical care to our patient population. Rishi Singh, MD, FASRS, Vice President/Chief Medical Officer, Martin North and South Hospitals joined our Board of Directors and is instrumental in the expansion of services being brought to the community.



Dr. Diamond joined Dr. Tapper at Symmetry Vascular Center and recently committed to seeing VIM Clinic patients too. Mary R., VIM patient, presented to VIM Clinic after a hospitalization for multiple serious issues. One of these included an area of lack of blood flow to her finger and Jordan Bromberg, MD, her primary

care provider at VIM Clinic, reached out to Dr. Diamond. He agreed to see Mary, did a full diagnostic work-up and expertly evaluated her. With close follow-ups by VIM Clinic staff and volunteer providers, Mary is doing much better and hopefully will continue her road to recovery.

**Sara Smith, BSN, RN** came to Symmetry Vascular Center as a charge nurse about 5 years ago. When she needed volunteer hours for her community health class at Indian River State College while getting her BSN degree, she contacted VIM Clinic, who was happy to have her join the volunteer team. Sara is now pursuing her MSN, Family Nurse Practitioner degree from Chamberlain University, and came back to VIM Clinic to get her mandatory clinical hours with both Clinical Directors, Victoria Dodds, DNP, APRN and Alan Eddison, DNP, APRN as her preceptors.

VIM Gala 2023


















## VIM Gala 2024

## 2023 Robert F. Novins Memorial **Golf Tournament and Reception** Aerial Shot of Oxypros Team







Initially, Dr. Nehra started as a gynecologist volunteer at the HANDS Clinic in Fort Pierce


