We have more in office volunteer providers and are so fortunate to be able to once again offer our patients counseling services in house. With our close relationship with Cleveland Clinic Martin Health we are now able to offer bariatric surgery to our patients who qualify. A Legacy of Care



Dr. Stuart Sabol, Otolaryngologist (ENT)

STUART SABOL, MD is the longest-serving volunteer provider at Volunteers in Medicine (VIM) Clinic. A board-certified otolaryngologist (ENT) with extensive training in head and neck surgery, and facial plastic surgery, Dr. Sabol joined the Clinic just three months after its founding in 1995 and has been a constant presence ever since.

As a board member of The Friends of Volunteers in Medicine Clinic, he plays a vital role in raising funds needed to keep the Clinic running. Known for his empathy and attention to detail, he treats each patient with the same care and respect as if they were a member of his own family. His volunteerism, year after year, has ensured that countless patients receive expert medical care they would otherwise not be able to afford.

One of the many patients touched by Dr. Sabol's care is Terri G. who first came to the Clinic struggling with several health problems, including cataracts, a breast lump, and shingles. After experiencing severe ENT symptoms that left her hospitalized, Terri was diagnosed by Dr. Sabol who took immediate action offering a treatment plan that helped her manage this debilitating ENT condition. Her primary provider at the Clinic, Vickie Dodds, DNP, ARNP, closely followed Terri's treatment journey, even attending appointments with her after the diagnosis.

When Terri's hearing began to deteriorate, Dr. Sabol arranged for her to receive a donated hearing aid – something she never thought she could afford. "I walked out of there in tears because I could hear," she wrote in a heartfelt letter to the Clinic. She is deeply grateful for the kindness and support from Dr. Sabol and the VIM Clinic team. Dr. Sabol's commitment extends beyond the Clinic. He has also volunteered internationally, providing surgeries and medical care to those in need. His focus has always been on giving back and making a difference.

WPTV Feature: Expanding Healthcare Access in Florida

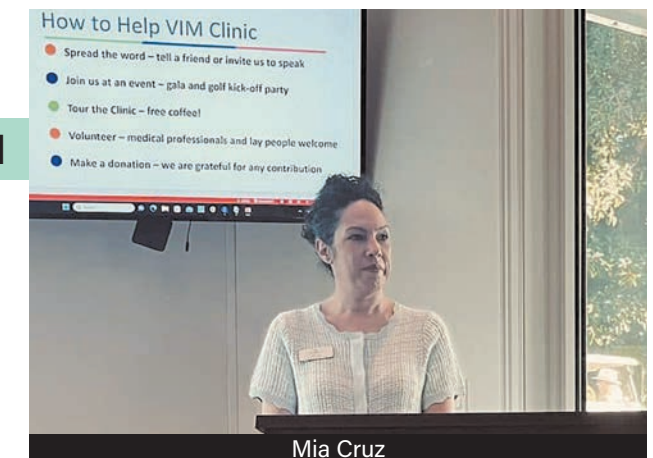


WPTV spotlighted VIM Clinic in a segment focusing on our recent expansion of income eligibility guidelines to 250% of the Federal Poverty Income Level. For 2024, this means the annual income limit is \$37,650 for a single person, \$51,100 for a family of two, and \$78,000 for a family of four. This change opens our doors to more people in need of healthcare services. The news story focused on how we're working to reduce barriers so more people can access our services.

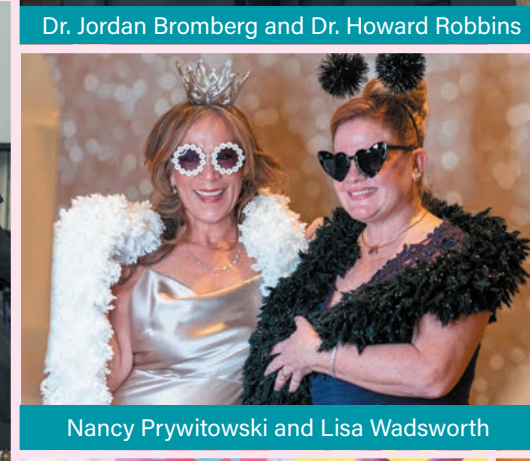

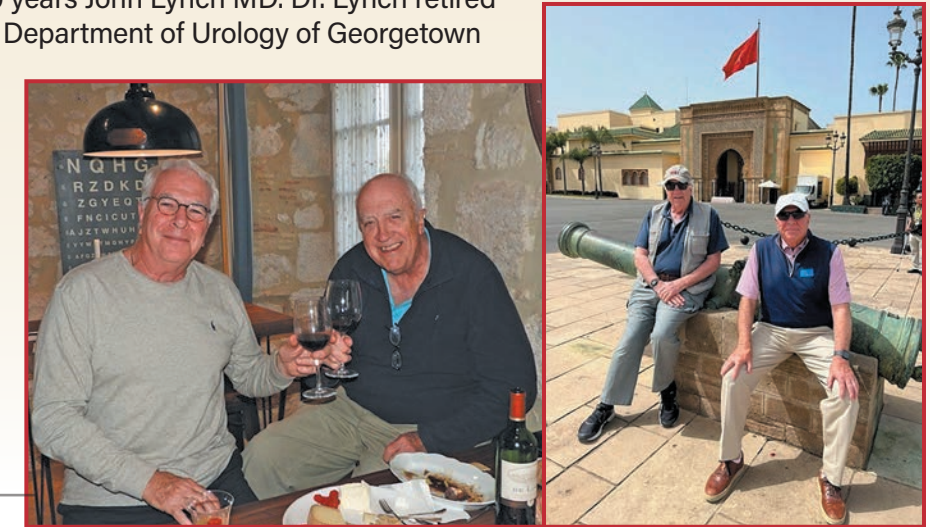
Gary McClain, MD

We wish them many more years of friendship, health, and safe travels.



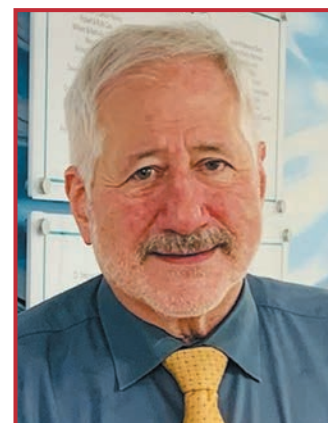
Stephen Cusumano, MD
